II. CULTURAL STUDIO ACTIVITIES

A. Malinggai Uma

Cultural education training for this studio is scheduled for each Saturday. Students who study here consists of elementary school students 09 Puro and SMPN 1 South Siberut. What we've found interesting about this studio is that the students are very enthusiastic about practicing and getting to know more about the meaning of each Mentawai song and dance they learn. It seems that the culture is already flowing in their blood. The YPSM team continue to monitor their activities and so far we've found no problems between the teachers and students.

We hope their spirit will never fade and they can help carry this culture through to the next generations and forover.

C. Uma Puumaijat

The team conducted monitoring in the village of Saibi on February 14 through until February 20, 2018. After arriving at Saibi, the public relations division and cultural education division helped teachers of the cultural studio and locals relocate the uma to the new studio location. This is done as a temporary solution due to lack of funding to construct a new studio. If the funding proposal for creation of a cultural center can be realized, then the studio in Saibi shall later be rebuilt and all the necessary equipment and learning materials can be fulfilled. After relocating the uma, the teachers and the YPSM team decorated and customised the space to become a simple studio. Finally, after the studio is ready for use, we conducted cultural education activities late into the night. The official schedule, which has been approved by the studio, will take place every Saturday afternoon and evening.

III. CURRICULUM DEVELOPMENT

Research was conducted by the YPSM team on February 19th at Malinggai Uma studio by discussing the contents of the program's curriculum. Then on the 20th of February, the YPSM team conducted research at the studio of Mr. Mateus Sakukuret by discussing about things relating to the Mentawai Uma. Following this, the research team travelled to Buttui accompanied by YPSM Secretary, Yan, on 21-22 February. During this research expedition, the team gathered research on the Mentawai uma, jaraik, skulls hanging in uma, about birds and the process of making sago. Further research is scheduled to take place here and in other large (traditional) Umas that are located deep into the forest.

IV. CULTURAL STUDIO DEVELOPMENT IN MUNTEI

To facilitate YPSM in conducting the program smoothly, the team asked the studio Jaraik Sikerei teachers, Mr. Mateus and Mr Maternus, to assist in finding an uma that can be used as a temporary cultural studio hub under the auspices of the YPSM Foundation. This studio will be used as the cultural cente until we can successfully raise enough funding to build the official YPSM cultural center. The suggestion was to temporarily use an Uma which is owned by Mr. Mateus Sakukuret. Thus far we have not had any troubles with negotiations from any of the parties involved.

V. VISIT TO TIOP AND SARAUSAU

On 28 February 2018 the YPSM team visited two villages, namely Tiop and Sarausau. The purpose of this visit is to meet each of the primary school principals in the two sub-villages to request permission and support in order to conduct socialisation activities at the school as well as the formation of a cultural studio in both villages to host the program classes. The details of these trips are as follows:

Tiop Village

The first village we visited was Tiop. At first we met with the headmaster of SDN Tiop. We introduce ourselves and the vision and mission of the foundation, followed by a discussion about our intent and the purpose for this visit. The principal was very supportive of the foundation's program, stating that they are ready to receive the YPSM team to socialize at their school. This support is very helpful for YPSM in implementing the program.

We then visited the head of Tiop village, but he was not there at the time. In connection with that we then travelled over to the Sarausau village.

Sarausau village

The team traveled to Sarausau with the same purpose as the visit to Tiop. Initially, we met with the principal of elementary school, then went to the head of the village. Unfortunately the principal was not there, but we met his wife who is also a teacher at the elementary school. The unique thing was that, when we talked to the principal's wife, it turns out they have been learning about the culture of mentawai such as handicrafts and food typical of mentawai. and that the principals wife is from Padang (Minang kabau tribe). Although she is not in charge, she is very enthusiastic about teaching students about the culture of Mentawai. This adds to our passion in opening the studio for the first time in Sarausau. We feel that through a collaborative relationship, we can produce good results in the future.

After our meeting at the principal's house, we continued our journey to the head of the village's house. Just like the Headmaster's wife, the head of the village also supports our YPSM program and will always open the gap for YPSM to conduct the socialization activities and form a cultural studio in Sarausau.

Siswa SMA Mulai Lupa Budaya Mentawai

MUNTEI - Siswa tingkatan SMA di Mentawai mulai melupakan budaya Mentawai, demikian disampaikan Ketua Yayasan Pendidikan Suku Mentawai, Marvin Satoko saat melakukan pelatihan dan pengenalan alat-alat serta aksesoris budaya Mentawai di Sanggar Seni Uma Jaraik Sikerei di Desa Muntaci, Senin, 22 Januari.

Marvin Satoko mengatakan, pihaknya melihat telah banyak anak-anak muda Mentawai yang malu mempraktikkan budaya Mentawai di depan umum. "Mereka merasa bahwa budaya kita kuno padahal itu sangat unik dan tidak dimiliki oleh daerah lain, orang luar saja jauh-jauh datang untuk melihat budaya kita dan mereka senang dengan budaya yang kita miliki," katanya kepada Puailiggoubat, Senin, 22 Januari.

Menurut Marvin, hilangnya pengetahuan budaya Mentawai di kalangan siswa disebabkan kemauan belajar dan mengenali alat-alat aksesoris Mentawai sudah menurun. Mestinya, kata dia, selain mempelajari budaya luar namun budaya sendiri tidak dilupakan.

Melihat situasi ini, Yayasan Pendidikan Suku Mentawai melakukan sosialisasi tentang budaya Mentawai kepada siswa tingkat SMA di beberapa kecamatan seperti Siberut Selatan, Siberut Tengah dan Siberut Barat Daya, Di Siberut Selatan pelatihan diikuti oleh 20 orang siswa SMA di daerah itu

Senada dengan Marvin, Yanuaris Mendrofa, staf Yayasan Pendidikan Suku Mentawai menyebutkan, tujuan kegiatan intinya agar siswa mencintai budaya Mentawai dan ingin mengingatkan mereka bahwa budaya tidak boleh hilang di kalangan anak muda.

"Kita khawatir jika ini tidak diajarkan 10 tahun ke depan budaya kita akan hilang dan generasinya tidak ada lagi, maka di tingkat

SMA dan pelajar umum inilah kita mencoba meng-ajak mereka untuk ikut serta untuk mengenali budaya kita sebenarnya," katanya.

Pemberian pelajaran itu akan menggandeng beberapa sanggar di Siberut yakni Sanggar Jaraik Sikerei, Malinggai Uma dan Sanggar Arat Sabulungan. Selain murid juga melibatkan 6 orang guru.

Silvester Sadodolu, salah seorang sisw SMA 1 Siberut Selatan mengakui, buday Mentawai di kalangan anak muda dan pelaj mulai pudar dan hilang karena perkembang zaman. "Anak-anak sekarang mulai mengah kan budayanya sendiri dan lebih memi budaya modern," katanya.

Sebagai salah satu bukti, lanjut Silve di desa uma (rumah adat Mentawai) sudah ditemukan, jumlah sikereipun ikut berku Menurut dia, budaya Mentawai sudah diajarkan di sekolah tingkat SMA. (g)

Usaka atapan pinjam, kata Saleh akun berjalan kalen si perunjam dan si pensimpan sahamunya sendiri. "Sinmennya nami jika ala yang menjampangembahannya mani tenta melalujurnemnya dan jika ala yang menyampun sahamnya na yang kita gunakan pun sahamnya na yang kita gunakan balannya serta hagi yang menangankia tidah berikan begita saja tesap kita melihat seperti apa si peminjam ina matinya," tajanya.

Ketika usaba ini berjalan, terikannya peluang matis mengarah ke air isi ulang keburuban masyarakat. Dalam menjalaskan usaba isi, Saleh menyebut secara bakum Bumdes Sejahtera uslah Jein Mendirikan Bangunan, Sunst Lin Usaha Perdagangan, Tanda Daftas Permahaan (TDP) dan Nomor Pokok Wijih Pajak (NPWP)

Yayasan Pendidikan Suku Mentawai Aktifkan Sanggar Tari di Siberut Tengah

Ann Sakas Mentawai mengefektifkan pengajaran sanggartari di Siberat Tengah kabapaten Kepulanan Mentawai untuk pembinaan bulaya kepada arak-anal sekalah dari tingkat SD sampai SMA dan ke warga setempat untuk mempelajari badaya Mentawai.

Direktur Yayasan Pendidikan Suku Mentawai, Marvin Satoko mengatakan sebelumnya sanggar bodaya di Siberut Tengah sadah ada binaan Dinas Parawisata manun tak berjalan maksimal, Tadi dari Sanggar Teniejat kita efektifkan lagi pembinaannya dengan manua Sanggar Pumaiya tapi sanggar Tentejat tetap ada jika manti masih di butuhkan Dinas Parawisata," ujarnya, Rabu 14 Februari 2018

Sanggar tari Pemaijat tersebut akan

dibina agar melakakan pengajaran kesenian Budaya Mentawai dari tinggal sekolah, SD, SMP SMA dan warga dari segi pelijaran tarah laggari dan kal yang lainnya meny angkut kebadayan. "Iadi pembirusan budaya di pendidikan kita akan bekerja sama ke setiap sekolah bagaimana si swanya dapat pengajaran badaya karena tidak adi ahasar sekolah tidak memperbedehkan siswanya ikar pengajaran budaya dari sanggar kita karena di setiap sekolah juga ada pembelajaran Budaya Mentawai (Bamen) imi," ujarnya.

Yayasan Suku Pendidikan Mentawai akan mensiliki kontribusi terhadap sanggar im. "Ketika hari ini sanggar Pumaijat sadah jadi binaan kita yang tentunya kontribusi kita melakukan secara pelan-pelan pembenahan fasihtas sanggar baik dari segi tempot dan kebudaan lainnya dan kita juga tidak main-enais lakakan pembinaan sid dan kita akan tempakkan staf kita di sini omak mengakorsodir sanggar nastinya." starawa

Selain di Siberat Tengah, Marvin menyebutkan sanggar kesenian badaya ini akan ada tempat lain di Mestawai untuk mendaparkan pengajar budaya "Di Siberat Selatan itu sedang kita jalankan dan di Siberat Barat juga kita akan bentuk sanggarnya," ujaraya.

Target yayasan ke depan, di Siberua Tengah sering berjalannya sanggar dan pembelajaran budaya akan meradirikan Sekolah Pendidikan Saka Mentawa di Siberut Tengah, "Dan target kita ini pelan-pelan akan serepas sekolah untuk pendidikan badaya inilah uguan kita agar

bajaran budaya yang sekarang sadah mulai serkikis oleh jaman," ujamya.

Ketua Nanggar Punaaijat Siberut a Tengah Jahuris Koboa Sikatsila mengatakan sebelananya sanggar tari ini sudahada dan selab melakukan pengajaran, salah camnya minal laggai ke anak-anaksekelah. Theba itu kita pakas sanggar Telejap binaan Dinas Porno sala kacenasanggar sukum, adanya yayasni ini kacin efektifikan kenduli dengan mina Sanggar Pumaijat tapi untuk Sanggar Tettiejah ika dipertukan lagi tetan ada, manya

Untuk pengembangan Sanggar Pumaijat, Jalunis berharap ada tempot yang layak nantinya untuk media pengaran budaya. Sekarang hiarlah masih pondok, delu ke dejuannya kareru kami sudah dalam nangan yayasan

tempat itu petlu kurma banyak yang man belaja budaya sekaligus juga te alat alat kebadayaan dan t anak anak dapat belajar d ujanya.
