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I. CURRICULUM PREPARATION

The team continue the development of curriculum study materials that will be used for teaching in studios that have recently been incorporated in to the Suku Mentawai Education Foundation.

On 7 November the Media Division, Research Division, Social Division and Ecotourism Manager conducted the first program curriculum research for November in the home of Bapak Faransiskus, who is also one of the interviewees. Then on the 13 November, the research was continued in the home of Bapak Mateus. The research with Bapak Mateus was conducted in the evening with the Media Division, Research Division, Social Division and Ecotourism Manager in attendance. The research at Bapak Mateus' home was the last of the research for November 2017.

We hope that in 2018 a range of research activities can be conducted in central areas such as Buttui and several other locations. This aims to speed up the bookkeeping process and reproduction of compiled materials into books. The plan for next year is the completion of each school level book by June 2018 so they can be used by students in July 2018 during the new school year.
